TRADE NAME CANCELLATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. The filing fee of the cancellation form is \$25.00 by check or money order.
2. Make checks payable to the Department of Assessments and Taxation.
3. Mail the form and check to Department of Assessments and Taxation, 301 W. Preston Street, Room 801, Baltimore, Maryland 21201.
4. Insert name of trade name on blank line legibly. Each person listed as an owner must sign with original signature (no stamp, photocopy or carbon copy). If owned by a corporate entity, must indicate the authorized title of the person signing for the entity.

How long will take to process my documents?

Regular processing time for submitted documents is about 4 to 6 weeks from receipt of document. Expedited processing requests will be responded to within 7 business days and require an additional \$50.00 fee; other fees may also apply.

For same day service the expedite fee is \$425.00. Same day filings for a trade name cancellation may be hand delivered to the drop box by 10:00 am Monday-Friday. Fees must be paid by check or money order. No cash is accepted.
